

Licensed Practical Nurse Program

The Practical Nursing Program prepares graduates to practice within the scope of the Practical Nurse under the direction of a qualified health professional within structured, acute, intermediate, long term, and ambulatory health care facilities. The practical nurse is a valuable member of the health care team who is active in promoting health, prevention of disease, and care of the sick.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Practical Nursing Program is 12 months and completed over three 16-week semesters. Each course is offered a minimum of twice per semester. Graduates of this program are eligible to apply to their State Board of Nursing to take the NCLEX examination to become Licensed Practical Nurses. Licensed practical nurses (LPNs) provide basic nursing care. They work under the direction of registered nurses and doctors. The employment of licensed practical nurses is projected to grow 12 percent from 2016 to 2026, faster than the average for all occupations.

SALARY

According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS), the median annual wage for licensed practical was \$48,820 in May 2020 in the top industries in which they worked were as follows

Government \$51,700

Nursing and residential care facilities \$50,100

Home healthcare services \$49,430

Hospitals; state, local, and private \$46,560

Offices of physicians \$44,830

JOB OUTLOOK

The "employment of licensed practical nurses is projected to grow 9% from 2020 to 2030, about as fast as the average for all occupations, said the BLS occupational outlook handbook.

About 60,700 openings for licensed practical and licensed vocational nurses are projected each year, on average, over the decade. As the baby-boom population ages, the overall need for healthcare services is expected to increase." Therefore, the need for LPNs will be in great demand.
